Executive Board Meeting in Novi Sad



At the Executive Board meeting in Novi Sad, Serbia, the acting Prime Minister of the Autonomous Province of Vojvodina, Mr Lódi G. Gábor, received the Executive Board for an exchange of ideas on the long-term care issues. It became clear at this meeting that in Serbia the expenditures for the social and health care have increased considerably in recent years and that the government is constantly trying to improve quality in this area. It also became clear during the talks that the institutions for health care receive greater financial

support and, therefore, the Serbian colleagues, directors of homes for elderly people urgently demanded more support for the care area. Another topic was the training of directors and the staff in the homes for elderly people (gerontological centres); possibilities for cooperation in this area have been discussed. At the end Wilfried Schlüter, the president of the E.D.E. (European Association for Directors of Residential Care Homes for the Elderly) emphasized that the E.D.E will, within the bounds of its possibilities, support and advise both the colleagues present and the government.

The Executive Board met at the invitation of the Head of Association of Directors of Homes for Elderly "Association of Employers of the Institutions of Social Protection of Elderly Persons and Adults of Vojvodina," located in Novi Sad, and dealt with the working and living situation in Vojvodina. As part of the meeting, the Executive Board visited a gerontological centre. The people there seemed satisfied with their living conditions, although from the Western European point of view, it was visible that both, the structure and the conception should be improved. In the evening, the members of the Executive Board had talks with representatives of another Serbian Association of Directors of Homes for Elderly (located in Belgrade). The decision about the membership could be made on November 13th, 2007 at the general meeting of the E.D.E. before the beginning of the 1st World Congress in Berlin.

The Executive Board has introduced the module "E-Qalin" for the E.D.E., developed for the training of home directors that must be obligatorily integrated in all systems for further education (duration: 8-16 teaching units). This is another milestone in the area of quality. Another topic was the further professionalization of The European Association of Directors of Homes for Elderly and lobbying in Brussels.
